Volunteering

The premiere of our documentary about volunteering called **Seeds of Goodness** and numerous awards at international film festivals. Four screenings with talks in different regions: Karlovy Vary, Uherské Hradiště, Prague, Hostivice.

Monthly meetings mainly for parents, but also for teachers, social workers, etc. Physically in Hostivice, online for participants from all over the Czech Republic and Slovakia.

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

Autism Friendly – a half-day event for children with and without autism, with a parallel educational programme for adults. Three events in Hostivice in the library and Sokol gymnasium, one event in Chýně.

Participation of children with autism at the **Festival of Young Talents** at Prague Castle and an exhibition of their artwork.

Co-organisers of the **Rokytka Challenge**, a charity hurdle race for families with autism.

EVENTS WITH CHILDREN FOR CLOSED GROUPS

Multi-day stays for a closed group of families with children on the autistic spectrum – at the Benedictine Monastery in Prague 6 and a remedial stay by the sea in Greece.

We are also **weekend guides** for families with children on the autism spectrum, organized by the Kolpingova rodina Smečno in the House of Families.

We gave lectures and talks at conferences: Intermingling of Worlds (Krásná Lípa), Mental Health Festival (Liberec), professional conference at the University of South Bohemia Life with Autism (České Budějovice).

In total, we worked with more than 30 families with children on the autism spectrum.

At conferences and discussions we had the opportunity to speak to more than 1,000 people, including students.

Volunteering

The premiere of our documentary **Seeds of Goodness** took place in Lucerna, Prague, in November. During the year, the documentary was shortlisted for 15 film festivals in the Czech Republic and abroad (Slovakia, Hungary, Spain, Italy, Moldova, India, USA, Congo) and won two first prizes, one second prize and two honorable mentions. It was part of the accompanying programme at the Karlovy Vary International Film Festival and the Summer Film School in Uherské Hradiště. In addition to the premiere, there was another screening connected with a talk in Hostivice.

The mission of the documentary is to show that volunteering is enriching for the child, parents and volunteers and has a positive impact on the society as a whole. It is a wish of ours that volunteering becomes common for people with autism and that there will be plenty of volunteers in the near future.

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

Autism Friendly

A half-day event for children with and without autism, with a parallel educational programme for adults. Assistants help take care of the children so that parents can participate in their programme. The events take place in as calm an atmosphere as possible (no crowds, loud music and flashing spotlights).

Children enjoyed music therapy, dog-assisted therapy, creative therapy, colouring, speech therapy, Lego corner, mobile planetarium, firefighters, police, rescue service, bouncing castle.

Parents participated in workshops led by experts, with topics such as A Kind Approach to Otherness (Václav Mertin), Autism Inside Out (Michal Roškaňuk), How to Dance with the Challenges of Fate and Yoga for Handicapped Children (Petra Fridrichová), Volunteering – a Network of Mutual Support, Music and Sounds as Tools for Communication and Calming (Ernesto Chuecos), Home Oasis – Aromatherapy, Snoezelen, Massage (Věra Petlanová Zychová), Music Therapy with Tibetan Bowls (František Horváth).

Four events were held: An awareness event for Autism Month in April in the Hostivice library, two events in the Sokol Gymnasium in Hostivice, and a summer outdoor event "Minions among Us" with a bouncing castle in Chýně.

Festival of Young Talents

We started cooperation with the Rotary Club Prague Golf – NGW and our first project was the opportunity to participate in the prestigious **Festival of Young Talents** at Prague Castle, where children with autism could exhibit their works. Children sent in their drawn or painted pictures as well as ceramic or paper creations.

Rokytka Challenge

With the Renaissance of Movement association we were co-organizers of the **Rokytka Challenge** charitable hurdle race. This allowed people with autism to participate in the race – they even had their own category and separate start. They could be accompanied by their family and children were helped on the track by volunteers.



"In everyday life, there aren't many opportunities for autistic (or otherwise special) children to have their own category in a public sporting event. It was an amazing opportunity for the whole family to play sports together and for our talented kids to see what they can do with the support of professional athletes. We organized a **weekend mental-relaxation stay** for a group of families with children on the autism spectrum at the Benedictine Monastery in Prague 6.

The programme included joint cooking, singing and dancing, dog-assisted therapy, a ride on a historic tram, special care for mothers and a joint photo shoot.
